Join us for a screening of the documentary *Project 16:49* to raise awareness about Youth Homelessness in Wisconsin.

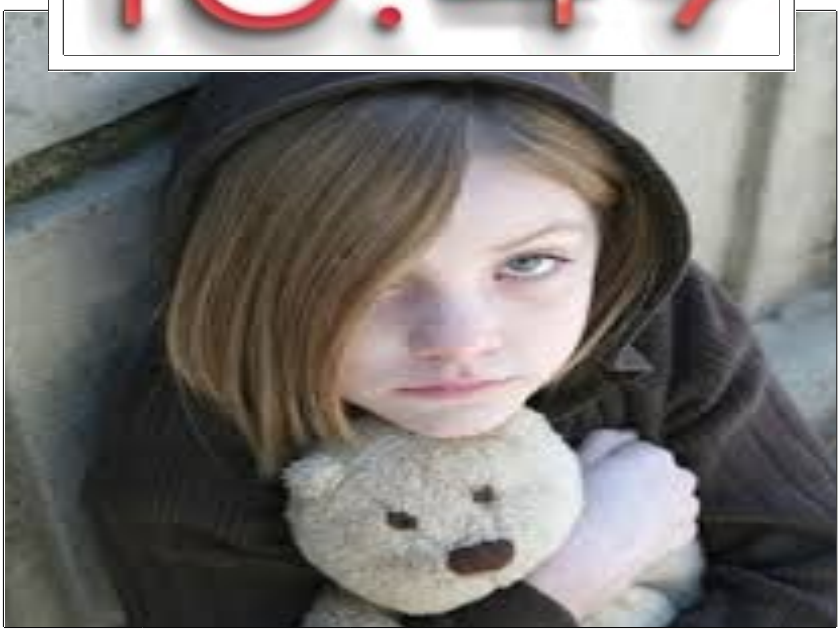
